

UP200 and Midnight Run Viewing Locations (see map for details)

- 1. Downtown on Washington Street.** The UP200 starts at 6:50pm and the Midnight Run will start 15 minutes after the last UP200 musher departs.
- 2. Marquette Visitor Center** on M-28 east of downtown.
- 3. Prince of Peace Church,** on M-28 one mile east of Harvey.
- 4. Lakenenland,** on M-28 nine miles east of Harvey.
- 5. Midnight Run only: MSU Agricultural Station in Chatham,** off M-94. From Marquette, take US-41 south approximately 15 miles to M-94, then turn east. Chatham is located approx 14 miles from Hwy 41 on M-94

More UP200 Viewing Locations:

- 6. Forest Lake Road,** appx. 3 miles from Chatham on M-94 East; the teams will run along the north side of M-94 until just east of Forest Lake Road. They will cross M-94 east of the dam.
- 7. Hiawatha Log Homes, Wetmore** - South side of Highway M-28 (this is an unassisted checkpoint for the UP200 and the public is not allowed in this area where the mushers and dogs are resting; viewing is allowed once the mushers leave the checkpoint)
- 8. County Road H-58, ¼ mile east of County Road H-15.** The UP200 trail passes close to the road here as H-58 curves to the north.
- 9. H-58 road crossing, approximately 25 miles east of Munising on County Road H-58.** Approach from Munising as the road is not plowed all the way to Grand Marais.

Grand Marais Viewing Areas – from Munising, take M-28 east to Seney, then turn north on M-77. The first viewing area is approximately 22 miles north of Seney, off M-77.

- 10. Turn West on Lowder Rd;** park at corner of Lowder Road & William Hill Road.
- 11. Turn West on Newberg Rd;** park at corner of Newberg & Hwy 58.
- 12. Turn West on Mixon Rd;** park where road is blocked – incoming teams will be coming directly at you down Mixon Road.
- 13. Ridge Rd at the cemetery** – the teams cross Ridge Rd at this point. Park on Ridge Rd.
- 14. Wilson St. at Alger Ave.** – mushers come out of the woods and come down Alger Ave. Park on Wilson St.
- 15. Randolph St at Alger** – park on Randolph. The mushers come down a steep hill and onto Alger St. (This is one of the best views when mushers are coming into Grand Marais)
- 16. Grand Marais Checkpoint Gate at Headquarters on Brazel St** – Parking is on the side streets, as Brazel and Alger Streets are closed for the race.
